PRE-APPLICATION ENQUIRY - OLD MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, SHEEP STREET CAR PARK, CIRENCESTER

I write with reference to the above site and hereby enclose for your attention a request for pre-application advice on behalf of Cotswold District Council in respect of the proposed demolition of the Old Memorial Hospital building and the creation of additional car parking spaces. We would like to request both a meeting and a written response following the meeting.

In addition to this covering letter, this pre-application enquiry comprises the following:

- Completed pre-application advice request form;
- Site Location Plan (with application site outlined in red);
- Indicative Site Layout Plan;
- Archaeological Desk-Based Assessment;
- Settings Assessment
- Historic Building Recording Report (Heritage Statement);
- Site Photographs (Appendix A of this covering letter)
- Parking Survey (Appendix B of this covering letter).

The Pre-Application fee will be paid by internal transfer upon receipt and acknowledgement of the enquiry.

The Site

The Old Memorial Hospital sits within Sheep Street Car Park, and is owned by Cotswold District Council.

The building was erected as a Cottage Hospital in 1873/5, and was founded by Allen Bathurst M.P. (later sixth Earl Bathurst) in memory of his wife, and for the benefit of the local community. The building has subsequently been significantly extended and altered, and was acquired by the District Council in 1988, once the new town hospital was commissioned and it became surplus to requirements.

Part of the building was demolished in 1991 and the surrounding car park constructed in 1992 (see Planning History section below).

The remaining building has been used for a variety of purposes since it was acquired by the Council; including offices, an internet café, children's nursery and registry office. The building is currently vacant and its condition is deteriorating. The building has also been subject to break-ins and anti-social behaviour of late, including an episode of vandalism of the building itself.

The cottages to the south western corner of the site were, until recently, wholly occupied. The use of part of this building by a local Counselling service has now ceased, due to its relocation to the Council offices on Trinity Road.

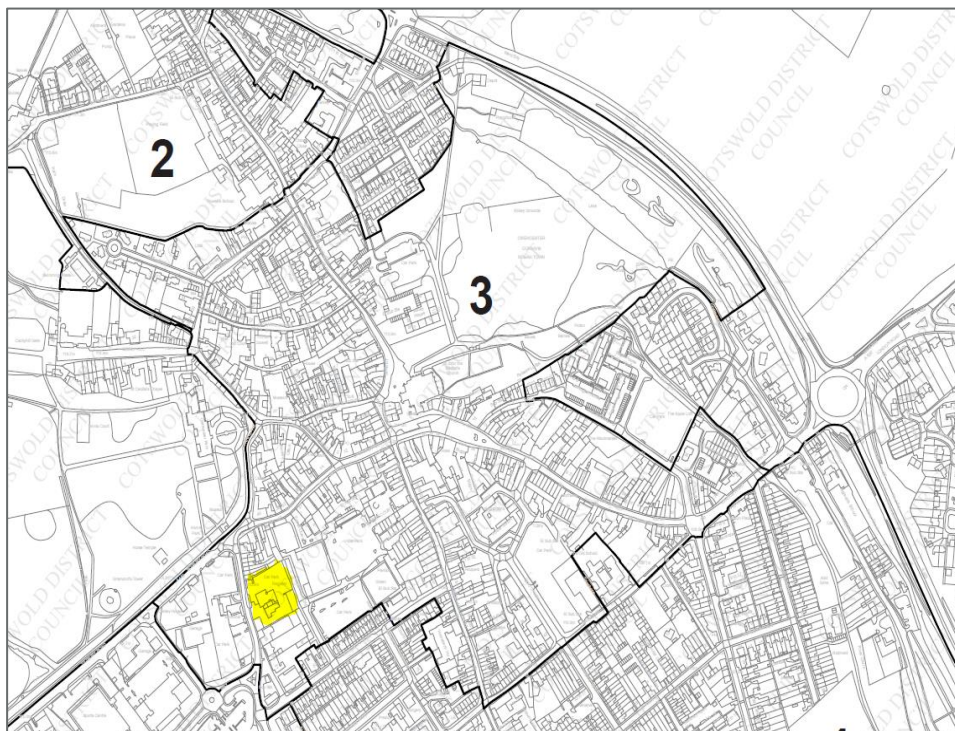
With the vacation of part of the cottages, which has freed up 2 previously private car parking spaces, the car park currently provides 81 public parking spaces (including 2 disabled spaces) and 3 private spaces for use by the retained offices.

Please note that the parking survey information supplied as Appendix B to this letter refers to 77 spaces – this excludes the two disabled spaces and the 2 spaces more recently freed up for public use by the vacation of part of the offices.

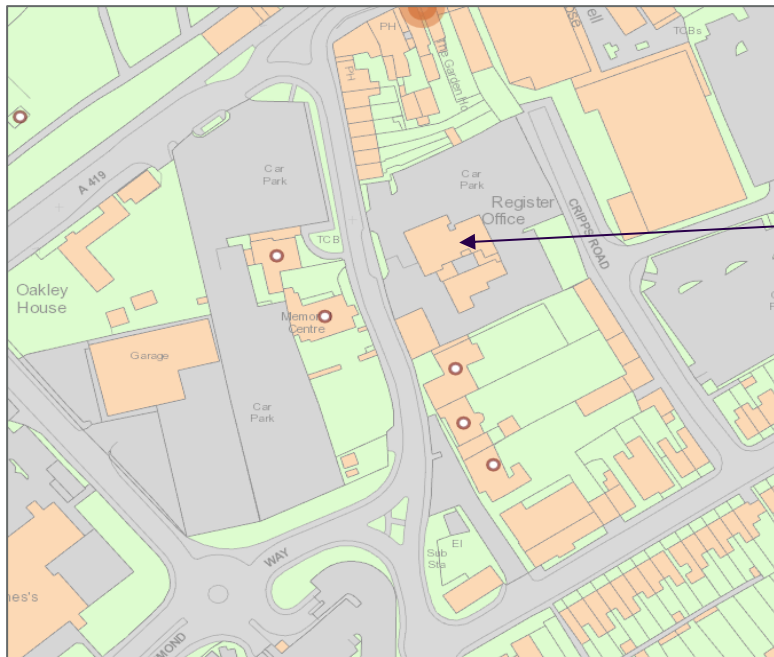

Planning Constraints and Designations

The building to be demolished (i.e. the former Hospital) is not listed, but it does lie within the Cirencester Town Centre Conservation Area (area 3 on the plan below with the site highlighted for ease).



The building also lies within the setting of a number of listed buildings – both opposite and to the south of the site - as shown by the red dots on the plan below.



Old Memorial Hospital

The building lies adjacent to a Scheduled Ancient Monument (shown red) ('Corinium Roman Town' ref. 1003426) and in an area of high archaeological value.



Old Memorial Hospital

A mature Cedar tree lies immediately south of the building.

There is a retained former air raid shelter to the south east of the site.

The site lies within Flood Zone 1.

Planning Policy Context

The Development Plan

The Development Plan for Cotswold District currently comprises saved policies from the Cotswold District Local Plan 2001-2011, adopted in April 2006.

There is also a Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) for Cirencester Town Centre, adopted in November 2008.

There is currently no Neighbourhood Plan made or in progress for Cirencester.

Relevant Development Plan Policies

The following saved Local Plan policies are considered to be of relevance to the proposal:

Policy CIR.4 (Memorial Hospital Site, Sheep Street, Cirencester) allocates the site (which includes the Old Memorial Hospital building) for car parking, until adequate alternative parking provision is made in or adjacent to the town centre.

Once such alternative parking provision is secured, the policy states that the site will be allocated for mixed-use (office and residential) redevelopment, subject to four specific criteria being met. These criteria are:

- Retaining the cedar tree on site;
- Provision of a public pedestrian link from Sheep Street to the town centre;
- Contribution towards the provision of off-site parking (to meet the needs of the development and the parking provision lost through the site's redevelopment); and
- The frontage of the Old Memorial Hospital and the Air Raid Shelter being retained until redevelopment has been approved.

Policy 11 (The Historic Landscape) states that within the historic landscape, development will be permitted provided it avoids harming the character, appearance or setting of historic landscape features.

Policy 12 (Sites of Archaeological Interest) states that development will not be permitted where it would damage nationally important archaeological remains (whether scheduled or not), or which would have a significant impact on the setting of visible remains.

Development that affects other remains of archaeological interest will only be permitted where the importance of the development is sufficient to outweigh the local value of the remains.

Where proposed development would harm significant archaeological remains, applicants should seek to minimise this impact by design solutions allowing the preservation in situ of the archaeological remains. The recording of archaeological remains harmed by development will be secured.

Policy 13 (Development affecting a Listed Building or its setting) states that development proposals will not be permitted where this would harm the character or setting of a listed building.

Policy 15 (Conservation Areas) states that development within or affecting a conservation area must preserve or enhance the character or appearance of the area as a whole, or any part of the designated area.

Proposals for demolition of buildings which make a positive contribution to the character or appearance of the conservation area will not be permitted.

Policy 39 (Parking Provision) states that proposals for a car park will only be permitted if the development forms part of a town centre strategy or traffic management/parking strategy; is essential for maintaining the vitality and viability of a town or district centre and genuinely serves the town or district centre as a whole; is located within or at the edge of the centre and is of a scale that is in keeping with the size of the centre; would help to reduce a significant traffic congestion problem or would not exacerbate existing traffic problems; and would not harm the provision of alternative modes of transport.

The following Cirencester Town Centre SPD 'proposals' are also considered to be of relevance:

Proposal 6 (Parking) states that:

- a. A comprehensive car parking strategy will be developed to properly manage the balance of parking needs, location and parking supply in the town.
- b. The principle will be adopted that car parking is directed towards sites that are easily and directly accessed from the ring road while recognising that visitor and shopper car parks need to be well connected to the commercial core. Conversely, parking should be discouraged at locations that generate traffic in the town centre or residential areas.
- c. On-street parking within the commercial centre will favour disabled, taxi spaces and loading/unloading.
- d. The Waterloo car park, and Sheep Street 'island' will be subject to detailed archaeological and geotechnical investigations to determine their suitability for decked parking.
- e. Streetscape layouts will be favoured which seek to design-out obstructive parking.
- f. On-street parking in residential areas will favour local residents and support local community facilities.
- g. Parking for commercial uses will be guided by the standards set out in RPG10 and the Gloucestershire Local Transport Plan Appendix I. Where appropriate, contributions will be sought towards the town centre car parking strategy.

Also of relevance is the **Cirencester Town Centre Character Appraisal and Management Plan**.

Within this Plan, the main hospital building is considered to be a 'Positive Building' (shown pink) with the later additions considered 'Neutral Buildings' (shown beige).



The site lies within Character Area 6 – Sheep Street.

The Emerging Local Plan

Cotswold District Council is currently preparing a new 'Cotswold District Local Plan 2011-2031'.

The Submission Draft of the Plan was subject to public consultation between 27th June and 8th August 2016 and will be submitted to the Secretary of State in the autumn.

Relevant Emerging Local Plan Policies

The Submission Draft policies detailed below are considered to be of relevance to the proposal:

Policy S1 (Cirencester Town) allocates the site for residential-led, mixed use development (ref C-97), with **Policy S3A (Retail and Main Town Centre Uses)** resisting the loss of existing town centre car parks until alternative provision is secured and implemented and **Policy S3F (Redevelopment of Town Centre Sites)** requiring a masterplan for the redevelopment proposals.

Policy EN1 (Natural and Historic Landscape) states that new development will, where appropriate, promote the protection, conservation and enhancement of the historic and natural environment by (amongst other things); ensuring the protection and enhancement of existing environmental assets and their settings in proportion with the significance of the asset.

Policy EN8 – Designated Heritage Assets – Conservation Areas states that development proposals, including demolition, that would affect Conservation Areas and their settings, will be permitted provided they:

- a. preserve and where appropriate enhance the special character and appearance of the Conservation Area in terms of siting, scale, form, proportion, design, materials and the retention of positive features;
- b. include hard and soft landscape proposals, where appropriate, that respect the character and appearance of the Conservation Area;
- c. will not result in the loss of open spaces, including garden areas and village greens, which, because of their openness, make a valuable contribution to the character and/or appearance, and/or allow important views into or out of the Conservation Area;
- d. have regard to the relevant Conservation Area appraisal (where available); and
- e. do not include internally illuminated advertisement signage unless the signage does not have an adverse impact on the Conservation Area or its setting.

Policy INF5 – Parking Provision states that proposals for public car parks will be permitted where the development:

- a. is essential for maintaining the functionality of retail centres as defined by Policy EC7 and demonstrably serves the retail centre as a whole; and
- b. is located within or at the edge of the retail centre and is of a scale, layout and design that is in keeping with the size and character of the retail centre.

National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF)

Section 12 of the NPPF sets out guidance for local planning authorities with regards to ‘conserving and enhancing the historic environment’.

Paragraph 129 states that local planning authorities should identify and assess the particular significance of any heritage asset that may be affected by a proposal (including by development affecting the setting of a heritage asset) taking account of the available evidence and any necessary expertise. They should take this assessment into account when considering the impact of a proposal on a heritage asset, to avoid or minimise conflict between the heritage asset’s conservation and any aspect of the proposal.

Paragraph 131 recommends that in determining planning applications, local planning authorities should take account of:

- the desirability of sustaining and enhancing the significance of heritage assets and putting them to viable uses consistent with their conservation; and
- the positive contribution that conservation of heritage assets can make to sustainable communities including their economic vitality.

Paragraph 132 stresses that when considering the impact of a proposed development on the significance of a designated heritage asset; great weight should be given to the asset’s conservation. The more important the asset, the greater the weight should be.

Paragraph 133 states that where a proposed development will lead to ‘substantial harm’ or total loss of significance of a designated heritage asset, local planning authorities should refuse consent, unless it can

be demonstrated that the substantial harm or loss is necessary to achieve substantial public benefits that outweigh that harm or loss.

Paragraph 134 continues that where a proposed development will lead to 'less than substantial harm' to the significance of a designated heritage asset, this harm should be weighed against the public benefits of the proposal.

Planning Practice Guidance (PPG)

Paragraph: 018 Reference ID: 18a-018-20140306 of the Government's PPG provides specific guidance about harm in relation to conservation areas.

This states as follows;

An unlisted building that makes a positive contribution to a conservation area is individually of lesser importance than a listed building (paragraph 132 of the National Planning Policy Framework). If the building is important or integral to the character or appearance of the conservation area then its demolition is more likely to amount to substantial harm to the conservation area, engaging the tests in paragraph 133 of the National Planning Policy Framework. However, the justification for its demolition will still be proportionate to the relative significance of the building and its contribution to the significance of the conservation area as a whole.

Main Planning Considerations

Both the adopted and emerging local plans allocate the site for mixed use redevelopment in the longer term, once alternative parking provision is available. Ultimately therefore, the loss of this building is generally accepted by the Council.

In the shorter term, and in advance of any re-development taking place, there is a clearly acknowledged requirement for additional parking to serve the town. The demolition of the building would add approximately another 19-20 spaces to an already pressurised parking situation as evidenced by the proposed indicative site layout plan.

What needs to be balanced in this case, is the extent of any harm that would be caused to the significance of the designated heritage asset (i.e. the conservation area or the setting of neighbouring listed buildings) by the demolition of this building in advance of the site's redevelopment, and the public benefits that would arise from increased car parking in the interim.

The impact on designated heritage assets

Para 7.5.17 of the adopted Local Plan makes it clear that the car park has always been viewed by the Council as a temporary use, pending the redevelopment of the site, which was proposed as long ago as the August 1999 Local Plan. In terms of the contribution of the Old Memorial Hospital, it simply notes that only "a small part of the front elevation of the former hospital building has some attraction".

Para 7.5.18 goes on to state that "additional temporary public car parking spaces, to relieve some of the immediate pressure on parking in the town, could be provided on the site through the demolition of the former hospital buildings." Recognising that this would be pending a longer-term solution to the need for additional parking in the town through additional parking provision on another site (or sites) in or adjacent to the town centre.

Work to establish a longer-term parking solution is on-going, but in the meantime the proposal seeks to relieve some of these clearly acknowledged parking pressures in accordance with the Local Plan.

The above comments from the Local Plan are very pertinent, because only part of the original building remains, with extensive extensions and alterations having been made over time, to the extent that it is only a small part of the original frontage that is considered to have, as the Local Plan states, “any attraction”.

The application to demolish the building will be accompanied by a Heritage Impact Assessment which will consider fully the extent of any harm caused to the Conservation Area and the setting of neighbouring listed buildings. This enquiry is supplemented with a draft Settings Assessment which concludes that the contribution of the Old Memorial Hospital to the character and appearance of the Cirencester Town Centre Conservation Area is **limited**, and the level of harm caused by the proposed development would be **less than substantial**.

Further detail is also provided in the Historic Building Recording Report which also accompanies this pre-application submission and which assesses the structural and architectural history and character of the building.

A recent attempt was made by a member of the public to ‘list’ the building, with Historic England taking the view (and the Secretary of State accepting it) that the application should not be taken forward to a full assessment.

There are some features of moderate significance within the building; such as the war memorial staircase and lift. The Council is exploring options for the relocation of the staircase which could be secured, if necessary, through appropriate measures if planning permission for the building’s demolition were to be granted. The Council is also considering options for the retention of the plaque on the frontage of the building and its ‘gifting’ to the Bathurst family. We will welcome the opportunity to discuss options with the Planning and Conservation Officers.

As mentioned above, the building is no longer in use and is falling into disrepair. It is also becoming a target for anti-social behaviour.

The NPPF is clear that where a proposed development will lead to harm to the significance of a designated heritage asset, this harm should be weighed against the public benefits of the proposal, which are discussed below.

In terms of the impact on non-designated heritage assets (archaeological impact) the application will also be accompanied by an archaeological assessment. It is of note that a desk-based assessment prepared in 2002 shows there is Roman and Mediaeval archaeology within the site. This enquiry is supported by an updated draft Archaeological Desk-Based Assessment, which notes that: *‘Ground reduction and surfacing activities associated with the construction of the car park would be comparatively superficial and would be unlikely to result in the truncation of any Romano-British remains’*. However the assessment also states that if the final proposals include excavation of the existing hospital foundations (in addition to demolition of the existing structure); such activity could have the potential to truncate archaeological deposits.

As mentioned above, the proposal would enable the provision of additional, and much needed, car parking for the town.

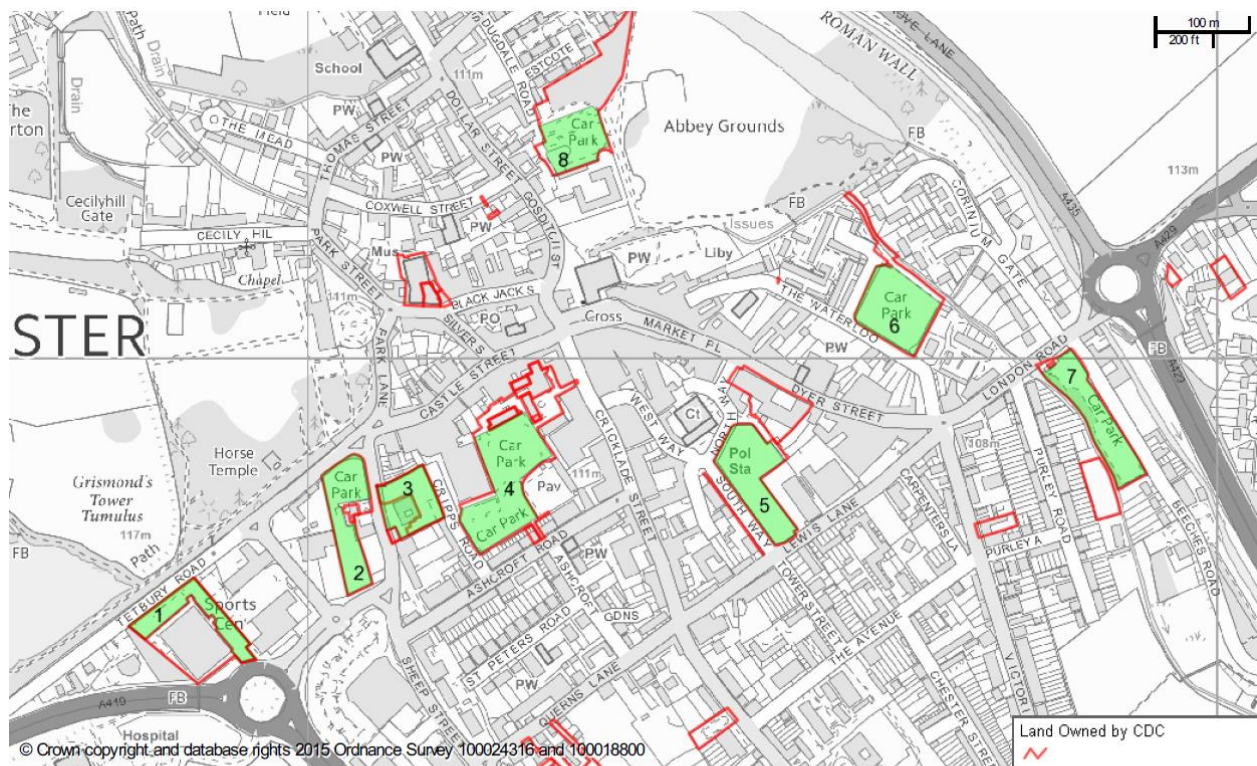
The District Council commissioned a Parking Strategy, which was completed in 2010. The report estimated that parking supply should increase by a further 75-150 spaces by 2026 to meet projected demand. The report concluded that there was a daily capacity of 150 spaces at that time.

Since that time the increase in demand for parking spaces has accelerated, requiring a greater number of additional spaces sooner than initially anticipated. In fact, parking data shows that between May 2015 and Spring 2016, the amount of parking capacity has reduced significantly with little or no capacity in car parks at peak times.

Further work is on-going to carry out a strategic review of the town and its parking provision to secure a longer term strategy to provide a sustainable car parking solution for the town to cater for increased demand up to 2031. However, in the meantime there is an immediate need to provide additional car parking spaces where possible.

To help explain the extent of the current issue, attached as Appendix B are the results of a recent parking survey undertaken of the town centre car parks.¹

These surveys took place between Monday and Saturday in February, March, May, June, July and August 2016 and surveyed all eight of the council's town centre car parks identified on the plan below:

As can be seen in Appendix B, the times when there are five spaces or fewer available in each car park are highlighted pink. In terms of Sheep Street, it is clear that, especially during weekdays, there are frequently times when there is no available capacity at all within the car park and when there is it is very few, and most often fewer than five, spaces.²

These results also show the extent of the issue town-wide. There are occasions when there are only 5% or fewer spaces available across the town's eight public car parks.

The implications of this for the town's economic future, and its town centre environment, should not be underestimated.

The demolition of the building also provides an opportunity to reconfigure the car park layout to:

- Enable safe vehicular and pedestrian movements; and to
- Make most efficient use of the space in terms of parking numbers including provision of disabled parking (at present there are just 2 disabled spaces) and motorcycle and cycle parking.

An indicative plan is enclosed which shows provision of six disabled parking spaces as well as cycle and motorcycle parking spaces.

It is proposed to retain the cedar tree and existing landscaping.

Other Matters

It is proposed that the application will be accompanied by a Bat Survey Report.

No advice has been sought to date from Historic England, however the client would be happy for the planning authority to seek the views of Historic England as part of the pre-application process.

The planning authority's view would be welcomed on whether there is an extant consent for the demolition of the former air raid shelter in the south eastern corner of the site. Our view is that there is, on the basis that application 91.00317/CT0128/2/A includes the demolition of air raid shelter, and that this consent was implemented within the 5 year time limit specified. Whilst there are no plans to demolish the former air raid shelter in this current proposal, the planning authority's view on this matter would be welcomed.

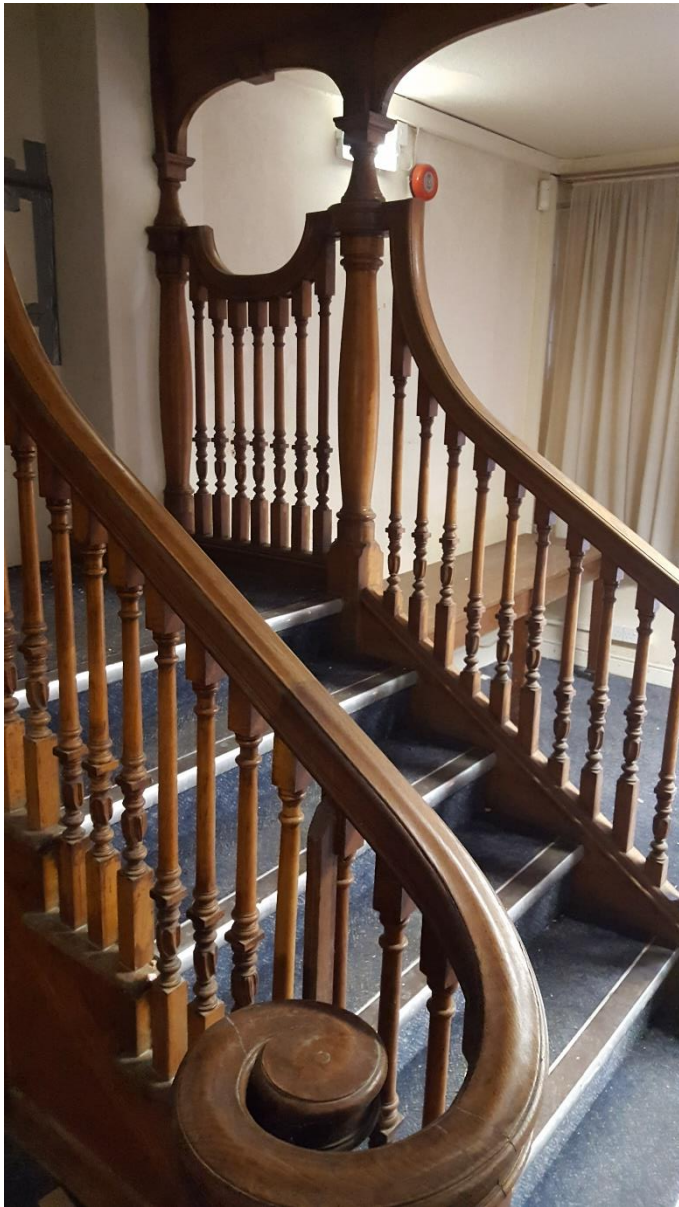
