Leafield Road to Hatherop Road" This is weak and should be amended to require such connections before any residential development takes place. Otherwise the proposed 80 dwelling development will merely add approximately 40 vehicles to traffic flows on Leafield Road, during the AM peak hour in particular, exacerbating the existing problems.
